Civil ceremonies are conducted in The Rose Room, a bright and elegant Regency style room with high sash windows overlooking Brighton’s seafront and promenade. The Rose Room accommodates a maximum of 40 guests.

As with all our services, our approach to cost is unique. The Rose Room can be hired solely as a ceremony venue for £200, but this fee is negotiable depending on the number of guests you have. Furthermore, the room hire fee is waved entirely for our guests or for couples who want to hold their wedding breakfast with us.

Provisional Booking

We will hold provisional bookings for you for 10 days.

Booking Confirmation

To confirm your booking we will need the following:

- A written letter of confirmation (non-electronic)
- A signed copy of the Wedding and Civil Partnership Ceremony & Reception Contract
- A non-refundable deposit of £250.

Numbers must be confirmed 21 days prior to function. Final numbers within 7 days of the event will be the minimum number of guests invoiced for the day.

The Proforma Invoice received prior to the function must be settled in full more than 7 days before the event. Prices may be subject to variation.

Service charges are not added to the food & drink spend and gratuities are at your discretion.

Cancellation

In the event that The Granville hotel and restaurant are able to re-let the facilities for a similar occasion, no cancellation fees will be charged.

Location

The fishing village of *Brighthelmstone* emerged as an important health resort during the 18th century and a popular destination for day-trippers after the opening of the railway in 1841. It was renamed Brighton with the creation of the Pavilion -- the oriental palace built by John Nash for his patron Prince Regent, George IV.

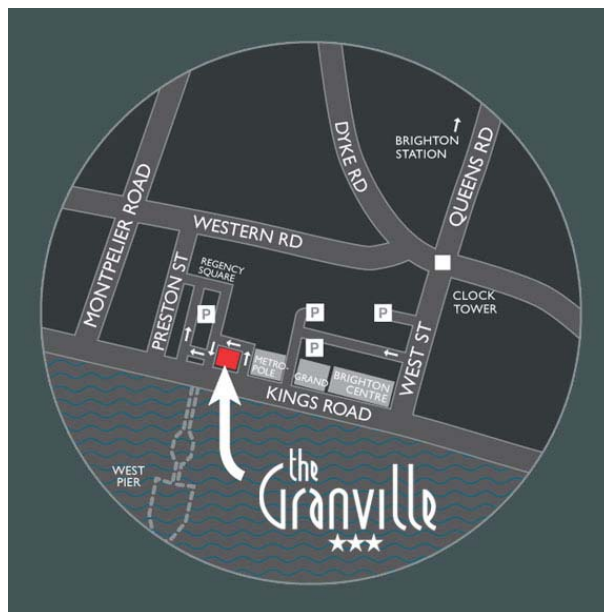
Along the seafront, the area occupied by the original village has become The Lanes -- a collection of narrow alleyways filled with antique and jewellery shops, fine restaurants, bars and pubs.

Named one of the first cities of the millennium, Brighton & Hove is a bustling place with a unique character. Full of boutique shops, award-winning restaurants, theatres, cinemas, and entertainment venues it has one of the most famous coastlines in Britain and a beautiful backdrop of the rolling Sussex Downs.

Parking
